■ **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:**

Kankab or Mayan soil, is an element in Yucatan that is located at the base of the domoic forms and because of its reddish color it receives this name.

■ **CHEMICAL COMPOSITION:**

Composed with iron salts mixed with calcium carbonate from the region.

■ **APPLICATION:**

Natural pigment that is mixed in small proportions with Chukum Base to give color to the finish..

■ **PHYSICAL PROPERTIES:**

Brown or reddish clay powder with iron and carbonate salts.

■ **USES:**

A maximum of 6.61 lb(3 kg) can be mixed with a Chukum Base bag, according to the desired shade.

■ **COLORS:**

Cankab Conkal (brown)
Cankab Tizimín (red)
